Grants to Organisations

Conditions for Grant Aid Applications

- 1. The Organisation must be a “not for profit” organisation.**
- 2. The Organisation must be based in, and/or serve, a significant proportion of Fairlight residents, or a particular group of Fairlight residents.**
- 3. The need for grant aid must be shown by reference to the published accounts and/or business projections certified by an Accountant or Banker, or, in the case of small clubs, a report signed by the Chairman or Secretary and the Treasurer of the club.**
- 4. National Charities will not be supported at local level by cash donations, unless they can show compliance with condition 2.**
- 5. Applications should state why the support is sought and how the grant will be used. They must also identify the group of residents who will benefit from the grant, and how many will benefit.**
- 6. In line with condition 3. all applications must be accompanied by a copy of the last available certified and audited accounts, and a projection of income and expenditure for the current period.**
- 7. Fairlight Parish Council can only provide grant aid to organisations within its own financial constraints. Grant aid will, therefore, not be able to be given to every applicant, however worthy the need, and no appeal will be allowed against refusal.**
- 8. Parish Councils have limited authority to make grants available to individuals, but will accept applications based on their merits and will consider them if they fall within the legal restrictions.**
