Project Update - Friday 1 May 2026

Fyrsway:

- The first section of Fyrsway (from the junction of Gorsethorn Way to the roundabout at the top of Fyrsway) has been fully reinstated and preparations for connections are underway.

Rockmead:

- We have made good progress on the second phase of Rockmead, reaching the tarmac section and completing reinstatement across a significant portion of the work area.

Broadway:

- Directional drilling and a small section of open-cut is underway on Broadway, progressing towards Lower Waites Lane.

Channel Way:

- Surveys have been carried out, and you may have had a door knock from one of our team regarding the works.

Overall Progress:

- To date, approximately 1060 metres of pipe has been installed in Fairlight.

What's happening next week (w/c 4 May 2026)

What we're working on:

- **Fyrsway** – Work will continue on the second section of Fyrsway, predominantly using directional drill.
- **Rockmead** – Works will continue towards Lower Waites Lane on the final section of Rockmead.
- **Broadway** – We will continue with directional drilling on the final section of Broadway towards Lower Waites Lane.
- **Channel Way** – Due to Bank Holiday Monday, we will start carrying out trial holes and initial excavations from the junction of Shepherd's Way.

- Road closures will remain in place around the work areas over the Bank Holiday weekend, with diversion routes also in operation.
- Please note that local road signs are legally enforceable under a Traffic Order. Moving or tampering with them is an illegal offence. Help us keep the neighbourhood safe by leaving all signs in place. Thank you for your understanding and support.
